MARCH FOR LIFE 2020

January 24, 2020 | Washington, D.C.



The march, which is the biggest pro-life event in the country, was first started in 1974 by Nellie Gray, an activist and Catholic who died in 2012 at the age of 88. Gray was a fierce advocate and a “voice for the voiceless.”

She laid the foundation for “March for Life.” Gray’s initial event 47 years ago has had a long-standing impact on the pro-life community.

On January 22, 1974, the first “March for Life” was held on the West Steps of the Capitol. An estimated 20,000 committed pro-life Americans rallied that day on behalf of our unborn brothers and sisters. Participants have marched every year since 1974.

President Donald Trump attended the 47th annual “March for Life” at the National Mall on Friday, January 24, 2020. This marked the first time that a sitting President addressed the event. Estimates of people who were there ranged from tens of thousands to a 100,000.

Trump spoke for about 15 minutes before the march began. Participants marched from the National Mall to the Supreme Court. Vice President Mike Pence and his wife also spoke to the crowd via video.

In his speech, Trump told the crowd: “Every child is a precious and sacred gift from God. We must protect, cherish and defend the dignity and the sanctity of every human life.”


